Since 1985, the Minnesota AIDS Project's (MAP) Legal Services Program has provided free legal assistance to low-income people living with HIV and their affected families. In 2005, the program expanded to offer a private pay option to those who do not qualify for free services.

With more than 20 years of combined experience, the staff attorneys at the MAP Legal Services Program provide specialized services for the community. We are passionate about serving the HIV community and look forward to working with you.

◆ OUR GOAL

The goal of MAP Legal Services is to eliminate barriers to maintaining the health and financial security of individuals living with HIV and their families. Our attorneys assist with:

◆ PRIVATE PAY SERVICES

Because MAP is a non-profit agency, our fee-for-service rates are very low. Some legal matters are provided at a flat fee, others at a reasonable hourly rate. A \$50 initial consultation fee will be applied towards your total charges. Our services are available only to HIV-positive individuals and their partners or spouse.
