

HOUSE KEY VOTES

1 CENSURE AMENDMENT
In 1996 the House voted 69 to 62 to approve an amendment censuring MAP and reducing its prevention budget by \$50 dollars due to prevention advertising alleged to be "sexually explicit, graphic and offensive." MAP opposed the amendment. Not enacted.

2 CLEAN SYRINGE ACCESS
In 1997 the House voted 68 to 67 to approve a change in the drug paraphernalia law allowing the sale through pharmacies and possession of ten or fewer clean syringes. MAP supported the change. Enacted.

3 BAN ON CONTRACEPTIVES
In 2000 the House voted 102 to 22 to approve an amendment banning school clinics from making contraceptives available to students without prior written parental consent. MAP opposed the amendment, which later failed in conference committee.

4 ABSTINENCE-ONLY AMENDMENT
In 2000 the House voted 110 to 14 to approve an amendment which would have prohibited schools and state agencies from undertaking any activity that could be interpreted as "encouraging sexual activity." MAP opposed the amendment, which later failed in conference committee.

5 REFUSAL OF PHARMACISTS TO DISPENSE CERTAIN DRUGS
In 2001 the House voted 63 to 65 to oppose an amendment allowing pharmacists to refuse to dispense drugs for moral or religious reasons. While the amendment was offered as an objection to the morning after pill, much of the debate focused on the impact to AIDS patients. MAP opposed the amendment.

6 DOMESTIC PARTNER BENEFITS
In 2001 the House voted 78 to 54 to prohibit the state of Minnesota from offering health insurance benefits to same-sex domestic partners of state employees. MAP opposed the amendment, which later failed in conference committee.

7 MARRIAGE-PROMOTION
In the last day of session, House members voted on an amendment to require schools to promote marriage as a part of sexual health education. The vote failed by a vote of 66-64.

8 MINOR'S CONSENT-2003 HF 352
In 2003, the House approved an amendment 92-40 that would give parents access to their minor's health records. MAP opposed the amendment, which later failed in conference committee.

9 MINOR'S CONSENT-2004 In 2004, the House approved an amendment 86-47 that that would give parents access to their minor's health records. MAP opposed the amendment.

SENATE KEY VOTES

1 **MINORS' CONSENT AMENDMENT** In 1999 the Senate voted 35 to 31 to support the law protecting confidential health care for minors. MAP supported Minors' Consent and the amendment. There was no House companion.

2 **K-12 SCHOOL HIV EDUCATION AMENDMENT** In 1999 the Senate voted 35 to 28 in favor of an amendment dismantling the only law requiring schools to teach HIV/STD education. MAP opposed the amendment, which was later removed from the K-12 education bill.

3 **ABSTINENCE-ONLY AMENDMENT** In 2000 the Senate voted 52 to 10 to approve an amendment which would have prohibited schools from undertaking any activity that could be interpreted as "encouraging sexual activity." MAP opposed the amendment, which later failed in conference committee.

4 **DOMESTIC PARTNERS** In 2001 the Senate voted 35 to 31 to prohibit the state of Minnesota from offering health insurance benefits to same-sex domestic partners of state employees. MAP opposed the amendment. The Senate later reversed its position, which passed in conference committee allowing the state to offer domestic partner benefits.

5 **NO PROMO HOMO-2003** Senators turned back an amendment to the E-12 bill that would have prohibited schools from teaching or promoting homosexuality. The amendment was defeated 41 to 19 with 7 senators not voting.

6 **REPEALING MINOR'S CONSENT-2003** [SF 1532] The Senate voted 38-27 to reject an amendment that would have dramatically weakened Minnesota's Minors' Consent Statute.

7 **REPEALING MINOR'S CONSENT-2004** [HF 2028] The Senate voted 39-26 to reject an amendment that would have dramatically weakened Minnesota's Minors' Consent statute.

The Key Vote Report is a record of positions legislators have expressed through votes and other legislative actions on defining HIV/AIDS issues.

Do not assume that just because a legislator voted to support or to oppose MAP positions in the past that they will do so in the future. On every issue, every legislator needs to hear the opinion of citizen advocates.
